- The scope of this version of the Bitly VPAT covers bitly.com (logged out) and app.bitly.com (logged in) websites, the Bitly developer documents site, the Bitly blog. At this time it does **NOT** cover the Bitly Chrome and Firefox browser extensions, the Bitly Android App, or the Bitly IOS App.
- Bitly is dedicated to maintaining strong accessibility standards and improving the experience for all users. To support this, Bitly uses the [UserWay accessibility widget](#) on its website, offering assistive features for users with different needs. In addition, Bitly regularly identifies and addresses accessibility issues through a combination of automated testing, manual audits, and continuous integration checks as part of its ongoing development process.

## Evaluation Methods Used:

**Automated Testing Tools:** Bitly testers use a combination [Axe DevTools](#), [WAVE Web Accessibility Evaluation Tool](#) and [Userway](#) to assess the compliance of front-end features. Bitly front-end code changes undergo accessibility linting using [Eslint - eslint-plugin-jsx-a11y](#) as part of our continuous integration process.

**Manual Testing:** Customer facing changes to the Bitly Connections Platform are manually tested as part of the software development lifecycle. User interface changes undergo cross-browser and cross-platform testing, color contrast analysis, and mouseless keyboard navigation testing. Additionally, [BrowserStack](#) is used to perform accessibility checks on a variety of mobile devices to validate consistent behavior across screen sizes and platforms.

**Continuous Monitoring:** Bitly’s quality assurance department performs periodic accessibility audits of the platform. Accessibility issues that are caught by continuous integration tests are categorized into a specific defect class in our Test Case Management system [Qase](#).
